

## URcast Teacher FAQs – January 2015



- **Is cached content interactive?**

In most cases cached content is interactive but check with your teacher support site, distributor or URcast for specifics.

- **What can't I cache?**

Some websites and digital text books cannot be cached. There are also certain videos that can't be cached. Check with your teacher support site, distributor or URcast for specifics.

- **How is the URcast app installed on the student device?**

URcast is normally downloaded from the OS store like any other app. URcast can also be installed in the imaging process for large scale deployments.

- **Will it integrate an LMS like Edmodo or Schoology?**

URcast currently does not directly integrate with LMS's, this may change in the future. URcast does work in tandem with LMS's.

- **Will URcast integrate with student directories like Active Directory or Power School?**

URcast currently does not directly integrate with directories, this may change in the future.

- **How does the content repository work?**

Raw content components such as individual videos and documents can be stored on a server and reused and/or shared with other teachers. The content repository can work locally at the school level. The repository works similarly at the district and even the regional & state levels.

- **How can students access Internet content at home or outside school?**

If the student can take home the device, any teacher selected content that is cached on the device can be accessed by the student regardless of connectivity status. Caching at the device level is especially effective for videos.

- **Is cached content interactive outside of school if in a WiFi environment?**

As long as the student is in a Wi-Fi environment the cached content has the same interactive characteristics as in their school's Wi-Fi environment.
